

**Oklahoma Athletic Trainers' Association
Professional Scholarship Application**

CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION:

I. To be eligible for consideration an applicant MUST:

- A. Attend a college or university within the state of Oklahoma in which s/he is enrolled in a master's program that concludes with an athletic training degree.
- B. Have an overall minimum cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- C. Include an unofficial transcript for all undergraduate and graduate completed coursework.
- D. Confirm his/her intent to pursue the athletic training profession as his/her primary means of livelihood.
- E. Be a member of the OATA.

II. The nominating Athletic Training shall be licensed and in and in good standing by the State of Oklahoma.

III. An applicant may be awarded a professional level scholarship only once.

IV. Payment shall be issued at the annual OATA Symposium Awards Banquet once an official transcript is received by the scholarship chair.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

I. The application must be submitted to the scholarship chair no later March 25th.

II. There are two sections of the scholarship application to be completed:

- A. An application to be completed and signed by the nominee.
- B. A recommendation letter to be completed and signed by the licensed athletic trainer, who must also be a current member of the OATA.

III. Incomplete applications will not be processed. All applications must be submitted to scholarship chair by March 25th, include a transcript(s), all necessary signatures and other requested information.
