

Nomination Guidelines and Application for the Oklahoma Athletic Trainers Association "Athletic Trainer of the Year" Award

Nomination Requirements:

1. Requirements and guidelines will be placed on the OATA website.
2. All licensed athletic trainers who are current members of the OATA are eligible to nominate a candidate.
3. All nomination forms must be returned to the Honors and Awards Chairperson by April 1st.
4. If not selected for the award, all information will have to be resubmitted the following year) if that person is a candidate.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must be currently licensed and in good standing, and a current member of the OATA to be eligible for this award.
2. Nominee must have performed a service outside of the profession of Athletic Training yet promoting the profession of Athletic Training in a positive manner.
3. Person nominating must send the application to the **candidate** for him/her to complete and return to the nominating Athletic Trainer. The nominating Athletic Trainer must also provide one letter of recommendation but no more than three letters of recommendation for the candidate as to why this person is being nominated.
4. Upon receiving all information, the nomination Athletic Trainer will forward all forms to the Honors and Awards Chairperson by April 1st.
5. A Licensed Athletic Trainer may win this award only twice. (No Exceptions)

Selection Process:

1. The Honors and Awards Chairperson will review the applications and forward applications on to the OATA Executive Committee for review and final determination of winner(s).
2. If a member(s) of the OATA Executive Committee is nominated, they will automatically become ineligible to review the applications or be allowed to determine the winner(s) of the award.
3. If the Honors and Awards Chair is nominated then all applications will be sent to the OATA President, who will then forward the applications to the OATA Executive Committee.

Notification Process:

1. The recipient will be notified by the Honors and Awards Chairperson or the OATA President no later than April 30th. This will give him/her adequate time to make plans to attend the Honors and Awards Dinner at the Annual OATA Meeting.
